HOME AND AWAY – LONDON (AILLEURS EN FOLIE – LONDRES)

19-22 February 2015, Mons, Belgium

A celebratory weekend of performance, film and interventions, brings the British Working Men's Club to Mons, European Capital of Culture 2015.

Commissioned by the Maison Folie in Mons, Artsadmin has invited a host of artists to transform the venue into a space for debate, celebration and creativity, in partnership with the London East End's Bethnal Green Working Men's Club.

From 19-22 February, *Home and Away - London* brings together some of the city's most exciting contemporary artists. Between them, they will provoke audiences to talk, share, think and play around notions of community and social change within the set-up of a Working Men's Club.

The clubs sprung up in the early 19th Century, and in the late 1970s and early 80s (a period of working class upheaval in Thatcher's Britain), they became a hub for communities across the country. Their essence will soon be found on Belgian soil.

The Home and Away - London weekend brings to Mons a glimpse of an alternative British culture, with wit and creativity at its core.

Each day the Working 'Mons' Club will be hosted by Mavis Davis and the Tabards – a troop of artists who will staff the Club, running games of bingo to the backdrop of real ales, pork pies and karaoke classics.

Featuring over 20 artists including Rajni Shah, Rebecca Davies and Andrea Luka Zimmerman, the programme takes you on a journey tracking the origins, deterioration and rebirth of the Working Men's Club, conjuring up the intrinsic values the space created. A typical day could include a making workshop for children, lunching on British pub grub, watching a film exploring urban regeneration, and listening to DJs late into the night. The culmination of *Home and Away - London* sees the community of artists and audiences who have journeyed together, gather to consecrate the Club around a ceremonial bonfire.
