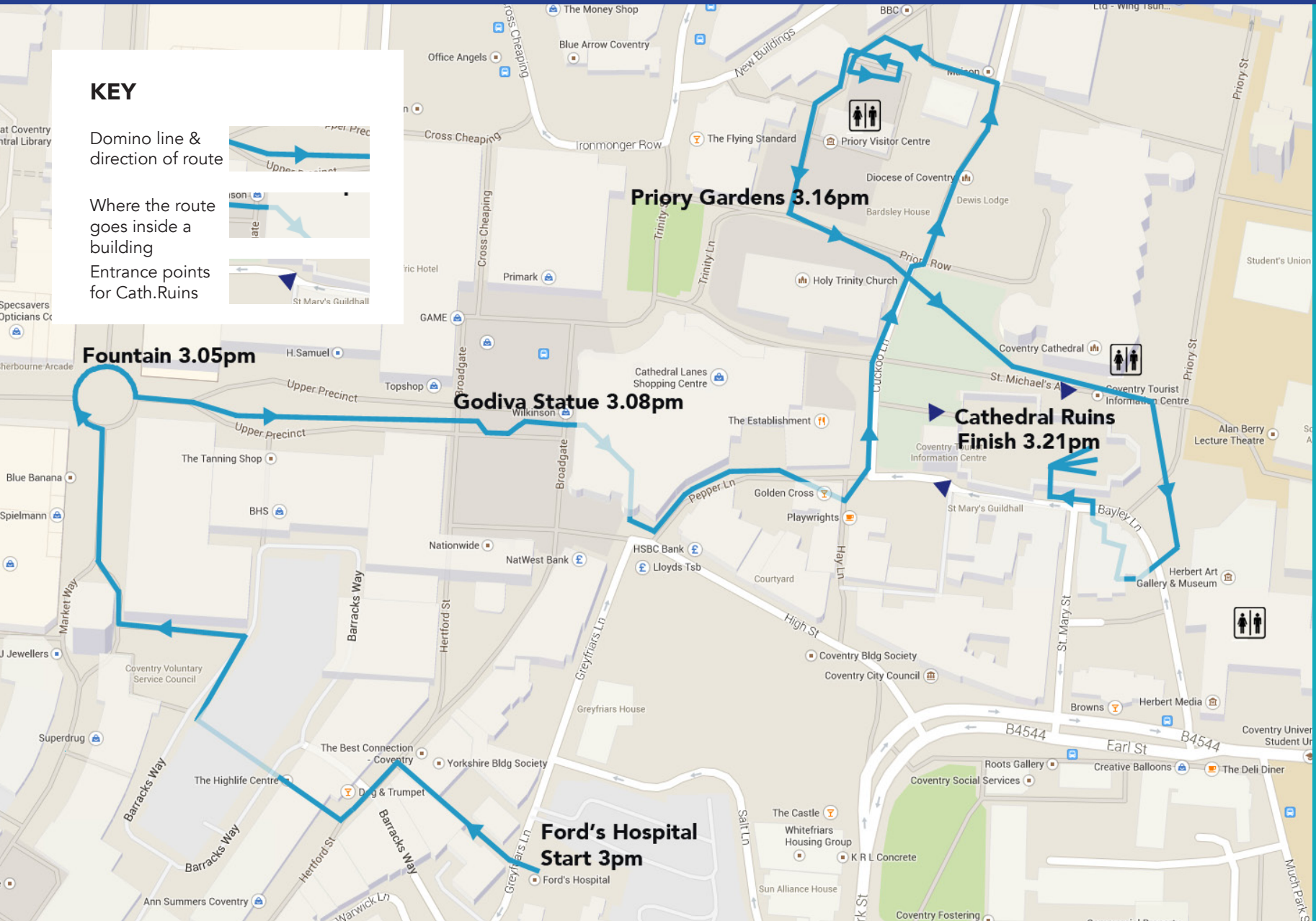
Domino line & direction of route
